We were running the Christmas loop which is fairly flat but wet rails forced us to cut out 5 passenger cars due to slippage with the full 10 cars.



## **3 Foot Gauge Track Update**

Below left is the first switch installed which is on the east side of the Horse Barn. Below right is Ken H changing the switch direction at mid point of the change.





Below left is a pre-assembled switch frog and on the right is a pallet of other switch parts for this second switch. There are guard rails, switch points, an actuator rod and handle, bearing

plates, spacers, and more.







At left are rails that have been rejected due to improper bending. The bender is shown at right. It is hooked onto a rail then the center ratcheting plunger is pushed against the rail until the

desired bend is achieved.

Sometimes the resulting bend is too sharp as apparently the left rail (in picture at left) has a kink in it on the near end (at red arrow, very evident in person).
