The Boy Scouts were at Carillon Park on Mar 24-25 for their over-night Camporee and the CPRSS club provided train rides and educational sessions. Below is Shaun H as engineer on club loco 7695. This was the first train operation in 2023 with passengers. The first regular public train run is scheduled for April 8.

At left is the low area just west of the Transportation building which has filled with water from the heavy rain the night before (Mar 24/25 – during the Boy Scout camp out, of course!). The "big" tunnel is on the far side of the lake. The water was almost gone by the end of the day due to the porous nature of the soil in the Park.

Eagle Update: Based on the eagle's change in behavior, it is believe that an egg was laid on Feb 21, 2023 and maybe another a day or two later. Typically, they would hatch in about 35 days - Mar 28th but we have not heard any confirmation of hatching yet.

At left is the grading by the big tunnel. Greg D brought his compact tractor to the Park and graded the trackways leading into ,through, and out of the far side of the big tunnel in a few hours. The far right track goes up to the tube tunnel and then into the fiberglass tunnel which is currently blocked. The track where the tractor is in the picture is the track that returns from the tube and fiberglass tunnels.
