Above is the crew setting up the track at the Dayton Train Show on Friday, Nov 3, 2023 at the Montgomery County Fairgrounds, in Dayton, Ohio. From L-R are: Jim E, Larry W, Bob H, Joe M, and Ken H. The CPR&SS club brings 280 feet of straight track, an electric locomotive and it's engineer's car, and two passenger cars.

Below is Ken H grinding a weld bead on the outer track to allow a joint bar to fit between two sections of track. Thom P is looking on. This was the last piece of track that connected the outer track east of the big tunnel to the track west of the big tunnel. At right shows Ken H on this outer track inside the west end of the tube tunnel just after the track connection at left was finished on Oct 17, 2023. Thanks to the many members who are restoring the tracks.





Below left are (L-R) Howard W, Larry W, and Thom P bending steel rails to a 50 foot radius on the Oct 28 work day. We needed 30 ten foot tracks or 60 rails bent. Below right are Jim H and Bob H assembling a track section using the plastic ties with molded-in tie plates and stainless steel screws. With parts at hand, a track section could be assembled in about 7 minutes.





At left are John L and Bob H with 13 just-completed track sections which are being moved up to the tube tunnel area. Below right is the area east of the tube tunnel showing the main (outer) track and the inner bypass siding. These tracks have just been placed in their approximate locations and have not yet been connected to one another. There may be some changes to the switch and slight adjustments to the final track routing. All of the track in this picture is "T" rail except for the switch which is square bar stock. A change to a "T" rail switch is being considered which would make for a cleaner installation.





At right is Bob S on the Oct 24 work day scraping the I-beams under the bridge getting them ready to be painted. Bob has also scraped and cleaned the bridge's top boards and gotten them ready for paint. Bob did get the boards painted with a first coat later this work day.



At right are (L-R) Dan C, Bob H, and Jim H assembling a track section using the new assembly table on Oct 31, 2023. We had been using two picnic tables under the shelter but they were too short, too wide, different heights, and prevented workers from getting close to the work which caused back fatigue. The new table is 10 feet long, 2 feet wide, and at a good working height. We moved it out into the sun since it was a bit cold on this Halloween day.





Above is CPRSS's display table at the Dayton Train show with Ken H working there. The straight track that the club gives rides on can be seen out the windows. We bring the electric loco in each night and charge the batteries.



Above is the LEGO train set that Dennis G donated for the raffle this year.

Below is a view of the track setup at the Dayton Train show. There is about 280 feet of straight track and a ride is all the way down and then back.



At right is Jim H carrying a load of passengers on Sunday of the Dayton Train show. The loader is Shaun H. The show had very good weather both days and a lot of attendees inside as well. We probable did at least 50 train trips each day but we didn't count them.





At left is Dennis G sitting in the middle of his LEGO display at the Dayton Train show. Dennis has contributed a LEGO train set every year for the last 15 years including this year. CPR&SS sells raffle tickets for the train set and draws a winning ticket late on the Sunday of the show.
