At left are John L and Bob H with 13 just-completed track sections which are being moved up to the tube tunnel area. Below right is the area east of the tube tunnel showing the main (outer) track and the inner bypass siding. These tracks have just been placed in their approximate locations and have not yet been connected to one another. There may be some changes to the switch and slight adjustments to the final track routing. All of the track in this picture is "T" rail except for the switch which is square bar stock. A change to a "T" rail switch is being considered which would make for a cleaner installation.





At right is Bob S on the Oct 24 work day scraping the I-beams under the bridge getting them ready to be painted. Bob has also scraped and cleaned the bridge's top boards and gotten them ready for paint. Bob did get the boards painted with a first coat later this work day.

At right are (L-R) Dan C, Bob H, and Jim H assembling a track section using the new assembly table on Oct 31, 2023. We had been using two picnic tables under the shelter but they were too short, too wide, different heights, and prevented workers from getting close to the work which caused back fatigue. The new table is 10 feet long, 2 feet wide, and at a good working height. We moved it out into the sun since it was a bit cold on this Halloween day.





Above is CPRSS's display table at the Dayton Train show with Ken H working there. The straight track that the club gives rides on can be seen out the windows. We bring the electric loco in each night and charge the batteries.
