All memberships of \$15 or more include immediate family members at no extra charge. What is considered “immediate family” is defined by the main member on this application form. Members included on this form have equipment operating privileges with appropriate levels of instruction, training, and practice. These privileges are granted with the expectation of helping on Run Days and Work Days, within the constraints of distance, job responsibilities, distance, and physical or mental limitations. Your active participation in the club is what helps to make it successful and fun. Members under the age of 18 are not permitted to be engineer for trains carrying members of the public (i.e., Run Days).

Memberships have the following categories:

- *Regular:*
 - Are 18 through 54 years old, have the right to vote, hold office, and chair committees.
- *Senior:*
 - Are 55 and older, but are otherwise the same as Regular members.
- *Associate:*
 - Are 18 or older, but may not vote, hold office, or chair committees.
- *Junior:*
 - Are under 18 years of age, and may not vote, hold office, or chair committees.
- *Visiting:*
 - Are persons who bring their own equipment to run at the Park, but are not CPR&SS members otherwise. These memberships are temporary for the duration of the event.

Aside from *Visiting* members, all other memberships expire March 31 of each year. These are renewed on an annual basis but can be renewed for multiple years at a time.
